

THE DR. HAROLD S. TREFRY MEMORIAL CENTRE'S Home Maintenance Program

Based on Subsidy Determination Scale

The Dr. Trefry Memorial Centre is pleased to offer Home Maintenance, which assists seniors and persons with disabilities by reimbursing a percentage of their costs incurred for housekeeping, yard work, and/or snow removal.

A client's reimbursement *percentage* is decided by a *subsidy determination scale* (below), which is based on their taxable income. For example, if you are sixty years of age or older and single with a taxable income of \$14,000, you would be entitled to a 50% subsidy rate on your eligible costs. On the other hand, if you are sixty or older and married with a combined taxable income of \$45,000, you would be eligible for a 5% subsidy rate on your eligible expenses.

If you are interested in and are eligible for our programs, you would be required to submit a copy of your last year's income tax assessment showing your taxable income (line 260). Moreover, if you are unable to find a service provider, we will try to recommend some possible providers.

SUBSIDY DETERMINATION SCALE

MARRIED	Eligible
Taxable Income	SUBSIDY
\$0 - \$22,750	50%
\$22,751 - \$28,250	40%
\$28,251 - \$33,750	30%
\$33,751 - \$39,750	20%
\$39,751 - \$44,750	10%
\$44,751 or higher	5%

SINGLE	Eligible
Taxable Income	SUBSIDY
\$0 - \$14,000	50%
\$14,001 - \$19,000	40%
\$10,001 – \$24,000	30%
\$24,001 – \$29,000	20%
\$29,001 – \$34,000	10%
\$34,001 or higher	5%
