- * Home Helpers are Independent Resource Contractors that are screened by the Home Help Service Coordinator. Screening includes a criminal background check, verification of professional credentials, and professional reference checks.
- Payment is required upon completion of work and payable directly to your Home Helper. Receipts for services are provided by your Home Helper.
